The Royal Thai Embassy presents its compliments to the Royal Thai Honorary Consulate in Vilnius and has the honour to inform the latter that, according to the Ministry of Interior of Thailand's recently launched tourism policy, applicants applying for Tourist Visa (single entry) to Thailand during 1 December 2016 to 28 February 2017 will be exempted from paying the fee of 1,000 Baht.

In addition, Thailand will decrease its Visa on Arrival fee from 2,000 THB to 1,000 THB from 1 December 2016 to 28 February 2017. Tourists from **Andorra, Bulgaria, Bhutan, China, Cyprus, Ethiopia, India, Kazakhstan, Latvia, Lithuania, Maldives, Malta, Mauritius, Romania, San Marino, Saudi Arabia, Taiwan, Ukraine and Uzbekistan** are entitled to apply for VoA with the aforementioned fee at designated immigration checkpoints, which will allow tourists to stay in the country up to 15 days.

The Royal Thai Embassy kindly requests the Royal Thai Honorary Consulate in Vilnius to publicize the information regarding the Tourist Visa fee exemption and Visa on Arrival fee adjustment on its website as well as at the Honorary Consulate.

The Royal Thai Embassy avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Royal Thai Honorary Consulate in Vilnius the assurances of its high consideration.
